

Read Me First

- 👁️ **Watch for traffic signs on the way home. For each one you see, tell your family one thing you remember about Joseph from today's Bible story.**

Joseph followed the "Keep Right" signs. He forgave his brothers, which was the right thing to do. If Joseph had tried to get even, it would have been a disaster. Your actions can't keep God from carrying out His plan. BUT when you forgive others, you can play a positive part in His plan.



READ 1 PETER 3:9.

- ⚠️ **Ask God to help you "Keep Right" by deciding that someone who has wronged you doesn't have to pay.**

Read Me Next Day 1

It's not up to you to punish someone for the bad things they've done to you. Make a U-TURN—show them forgiveness instead. That's not easy, so make sure you ask for God's help.



READ LEVITICUS 19:18.

- 👁️ **Practice some opposites. Mark the ones you do:**

- eat or write using your opposite hand
- forgive instead of getting even
- pray AFTER a meal instead of before
- make a U-turn sign for your room

- ⚠️ **Ask God to help you love others enough to forgive them.**

Read Me Next Day 3

Look at the lines below. Which one is longest?



- 👁️ **Don't be fooled. The lines appear to be different lengths but they're actually all the same.**

READ PROVERBS 24:29.

CAUTION: It's dangerous to try and get even. Don't be fooled into thinking it's okay to make someone pay for what they've done. You could end up doing something even worse than what they did! Do the opposite—FORGIVE them.



- ⚠️ **Ask God to help you be careful not to get even.**

Read Me Next Day 2

When you want to get even with someone, STOP! and think about the way God forgives you. He doesn't do stuff to get even with you for disobeying Him. He loves you too much for that.

READ PSALM 103:10-11.

- 👁️ **Make some stop signs on paper plates. In your own words, write out Psalm 103:10-11 on them. Place them around the house. Whenever you see one, STOP! in your tracks and check your attitude.**



- ⚠️ **Thank God for His love and ask Him to help you love others the way He does.**

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
